Chapter 17 NEEDS YOU...to support our 2025 Camp Corral Fundraising Activity.

Beginning on Friday, April 4, 2025, volunteers are needed to represent Chapter 17 of the Disabled American Veterans (DAV) at the **Golden Corral Restaurant #2486**, located in the Largo Town Center at **1001 Shoppers Way, Upper Marlboro, Maryland 20774**. This fundraising activity will continue on each Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, concluding on Saturday, May 31, 2025.

Number of volunteers needed per shift: The DAV **Golden Corral Fundraiser** is seeking **at least two (2) volunteers per shift** at our table at a time. **We will not deviate from this policy** as there will be plenty of opportunities throughout the fundraising period available for a member to sign up and perform on a shift.

Volunteer signup schedule: Please review the attached schedule (Table 1), decide on which day or days and times that you can volunteer, and then add your last name and first initial to the schedule. **NOTE: These are two four (4) hour shifts: one (1) on Fridays and Saturdays, with one (1) five (5) hour shift on Sundays.** If you cannot commit to the entire four (4) or five (5) hour shift, then we understand. Let us know so that we can have someone fill in for the remainder of the time that you sign up for should your schedule not allow for you to cover a whole shift. Send Comrade Alexander an email and in the Subject line, put **Camp Corral Volunteer** and then include the day or days and times that you would like to volunteer for and please include a contact phone number for our point of contact.

Volunteers are being asked to *wear DAV, DAVA, or other military gear* (representing your branch of service) while at the Golden Corral and provide a contact number so that they can be informed in the event that changes occur to this schedule. Also, if a volunteer signs up for a shift and an emergency situation arises that will prevent them from fulfilling their commitment for that shift, then contact 2nd Junior Vice Commander Alexander or Adjutant Dent so that we can ensure that there are an adequate number of volunteers available for that shift.

Accounting: Funds that are collected at the Golden Corral Fundraiser will be counted by one of the volunteers and one of the restaurant managers. Upon agreement on the amount collected, the restaurant manager will log the daily entry into a spreadsheet and place the funds in the safe. At the end of the fundraising period, the **DAV Chapter Program Coordinator will provide an After Action Report** and send it **to the Department of Maryland Golden Corral Chairperson**, Mattie Whitfield at mwhitfield@verizon.net.

SPECIAL NOTE: Volunteers will be allowed to request refreshments (coffee, tea, soft drinks, water) from the Golden Corral staff and be able to consume a meal at the end of their shift.

Carrying out a meal is not allowed. This is a restaurant that has carry out service and for those who choose this option, then they must pay for their meal. No exceptions!!!
