OUTSTANDING CHAPTER OF THE YEAR

The criteria outlined below may be used for submitting your chapter for consideration for the **2010 Outstanding Chapter of the Year Award**. All entries will be judged by the Public Relations & Awards Committee, and the Chapter chosen as the Outstanding Chapter will be awarded the **David E. Smith Trophy** and \$500 at the Convention Banquet.

Criteria used for evaluating:

- 1. Membership promotion program used by the Chapter and the results.
- 2. Chapter's participation in veteran organizations' functions in the community.
- 3. Participation in the DAV Zones, Department and National level functions, to include programs, conventions, conferences, etc.
- 4. Chapter meetings Special programs, functions, speakers, etc.
- 5. Fund Raising activities.
- 6. Donations to hospitals VA, local and Veterans Home families or individuals in need, organizations, etc.
- 7. Participation in community events.
- 8. Publicity.
- 9. Taking part in legislative procedures.
- 10. Visits and programs at hospitals, nursing homes, etc. (Include photos, clippings, etc.)

The *David E. Smith Trophy* was established in honor of Past Department Commander David E. Smith. The trophy will be awarded each year at the State convention.

All entries must be submitted to the Department Adjutant prior to the 1st Business Session of the Department Convention on Friday afternoon, June 11, 2010 at the Kewadin Convention Center in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan.

DAV 2010 JAMES R. FRIESEMA PUBLIC RELATIONS AWARD

This award is made to recognize the public relations accomplishments of one DAV Chapter in Michigan. The award was named for the late James R. Friesema, Past State Commander 1973-74, because of his involvement with public relations and concern for the DAV. The award will be presented to the one-Chapter in the state judged to have carried out the best DAV public relations program for the current year. All DAV Michigan Chapters are eligible to compete for the awards.

The <u>one DAV Chapter</u> which contributed most to the public's knowledge and appreciation of DAV activities and objectives, will be the criteria for selecting an annual winner.

COMPETITION RULES ARE:

- Page size of entries shall be confined to 81/2" X 11" with covers no larger than 9" X 12'.
 The Chapter name and address, etc. should appear on the cover or first page.
- It is suggested, but not mandatory, that the roster of officers is your second page and a statement by the Chapter Commander and/or Public Relations Officer, describing the PR program for the year, be your third page. Evidence supporting this program should also be included in the book.
- The balance of the book should contain: News items, radio or TV time accorded; DAV Chapter community projects and programs; photos taken at these or local Chapter events; letters received by the Chapter with public relations significance; advertisements and mail pieces produced by the Chapter; letters from broadcast media representatives documenting aired Chapter publicity; and evidence of other Chapter activity building a favorable public image of the DAV.

The organization of material in the book is left to the discretion of those responsible for its preparation. Neatness and artistic merit are encouraged, but entries will be judged solely on the effectiveness of Chapter public relations programs.

Materials presented must have taken place between July I and June 30 of the <u>CURRENT 2009-10 MEMBERSHIP YEAR</u>. Entries <u>MUST</u> be submitted NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, JUNE 11, 2010 <u>before</u> the first Convention business session.

CRITERIA FOR EVALUATING

Newsworthiness of content
Quality and accuracy of information
Relevance, interest and clarity of news presented
Style, format and neatness
Frequency and regularity of publication

Entries for this award will be judged by members of the Public Relations and Awards Committee and may be sent to Department headquarters thirty (30) days in advance of the Department Convention, or presented to the PR and Awards Committee before the first Convention business session, on Friday, June 11, 2010.

A <u>minimum of three/maximum of five separate issues</u> of the newsletter or bulletin to be considered, shall be submitted for Committee consideration.

Year 2010 DAV Chapter Americanism Award

GUIDELINES FOR CHAPTER AMERICANISM BOOKS

One award will be presented at the 2010 State Convention to the chapter who, overall, puts on the best Americanism program during the past year.

- 1) Books should be on the order of a photo album or a scrapbook.
- 2) Cover of books may be decorated to suit your fancy.
- 3) The book should include the Chapter name and number, the zone in which the chapter belongs, along with the name of the Chapter Americanism Chairman. You may also include the names of the individuals who worked on the book.
- 4) Individual sheets of paper should describe each event, in order of its occurrence. Use more than one page if necessary. Supporting material should follow the description of the event.
- 5) Pictures, to be used as supporting material for an event, should be clearly identified, typed or hand-printed in double-space with a dated caption beneath the picture, making sure to identify at least one chapter member by title and name, if none, name and title of any one person in picture, the place and the event.
- 6) Newspaper articles that are submitted as supporting material must have the actual newspaper masthead and the date (cutout).
- 7) Radio and TV spots that your Chapter took part in seeing they were aired may be written up as an event.
- 8) You may include as many events as your Chapter deems appropriate. Such as your Chapter's active participation in: Memorial Day, Flag Day, Veterans Day, POW Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, a Veteran's funeral (with or without honor guard), a building and/or Flag dedication, or any other involvement in promoting patriotism within your local government or community.
- 9) All events must have taken place during the current 2009-2010 membership year, from July 1st thru June 30th. Americanism books can either be mailed to the Department office to be received no later than May 29, or can be hand-delivered to the convention prior to the first business session on Friday, June 11, 2010.

All Americanism books will be returned after judging, upon request.

<u>Deadline</u>: All posters that are <u>mailed</u> to the DAV must be received no later than May 29, 2010. Entries can be turned in at any local DAV chapter who should take them to our annual State convention being held in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan to submit prior to judging by Friday, June 11, 2010.

Year 2010 DAV Child Welfare Reports



Every Chapter is asked to submit a report on its Child Welfare activities during the 2009-10 year.

When submitting a Chapter report, be sure to include the name, event and any other pertinent information. The report should be brief, but to the point.

Child Welfare activities could include:

* Support of Operation Military Kids, Family support of active military personnel or Michigan Reserve Component soldiers who are suffering financial hardships as a result of active duty or an in the line of duty related injury or illness.



* Aid and assist orphan(s) of wartime disabled veterans.

Other activities that might be included in the report are:

*Chapter hosted a children's holiday party, a birthday party or sponsored an organized trip.

* Your chapter held a Veterans Day program at a local school, arranged a tour of the local fire department or police station; or a chapter member volunteered as a Big Brother or Big Sister.
