 Commander's Corner



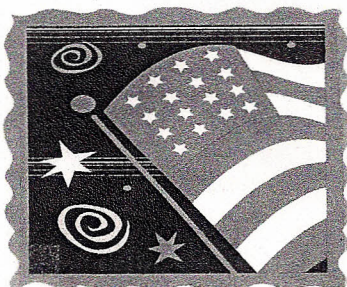

Governor McDonnell Launches New Veterans ID Card

RICHMOND, VA (AP) - Virginia's veterans are getting new IDs to help them take advantage of special discount programs. Gov. Bob McDonnell will launch a new Virginia Veterans ID Card on Wednesday during an event at the McGuire Veterans Affairs Medical Center in Richmond. McDonnell's administration created the new identification card to serve as proof of veteran status. It can be used to obtain discounts at stores, state parks and other businesses. The DMV 2 Go mobile customer service center will be available to process applications for the new cards.

NOTE: ID card will be mailed to the address currently shown on your DMV record. To change or correct your address, submit Address Change Request (ISD 01) form.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS			
To qualify for a Virginia Veterans Identification Card, the applicant must:			
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • be a Virginia resident, • hold an unexpired Virginia License/Learner's Permit or Identification Card, • have served in the U.S. Armed Forces and received a discharge status other than dishonorable and, • present a photocopy of a veteran service proof document (eg. DD-214, DD 256 or WD AGO forms). 			
When you submit this application for a Virginia Veterans Identification Card, you give consent for the information on this form - and any subsequent address change you make - to be shared with the Virginia Department of Veterans Services.
