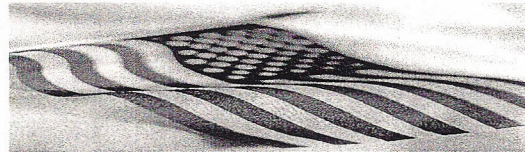
DAVA Mission Statement:
